MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Please register me as a member of Fruit Valley Farms Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program for the upcoming growing season. I understand that farming is a seasonal and unpredictable undertaking, and that exact selections included in the weekly distribution will change as the season progresses. In joining the CSA, I agree to share in the fluctuations and variations inherent in farming, and understand that my produce will be grown with sound farming practices. In the event of catastrophic crop loss due to severe weather conditions, we will do all we can to overcome any crop damage. However, please be advised that that may not always be possible. By joining the program you agree to share in such a risk, should it occur, and will not expect any reimbursement for any lost weeks. **If you do not wish to take that risk, please do not register.**

You will have a choice between 3 days in which to pick up your baskets:
